Article 1. General

Native Nation, with headquarters at Doornelei 1, 2018 Antwerp (Belgium), registered at the CBE by number 0651.632.241 (hereinafter "Native Nation") is responsible for the processing of your personal data on the website www.nativenation.eu.

Native Nation applies the "Law of 30 July 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data" in accordance with Regulation 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (hereinafter "GDPR").

Article 2. Collected personal data

In the context of its activities, Native Nation processes your personal data. This concerns:

- Category 1: based on cookies and similar technologies: your IP address, the browser type and version of your navigation system, the pages you have visited, surfing behaviour (more information on how we use cookies can be found in article 8;
- **Category 2**: based on an online form on our website: your first and last name, email address and all information you communicate to us in the message box;
- Category 3: when subscribing to our newsletter: your first and last name, email address;



- **Category 4**: when you enter into into a contest (e.g. give-away): your first and last name, email address;
- **Category 5**: personal data communicated by commercial partners of Native Nation. In this case, the commercial partners of Native Nation guarantee to Native Nation that they have actually received the authorization to communicate these personal data.
- Category 6: identification data of press and suppliers;
- **Category 7**: recruiting: personal data such as your first and last name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, data related to education and work experience.

Article 3. Purposes of the processing of data

- Category 1: to offer you the services of the website, maintain and improve our website and compile anonymous statistics or lead an investigation regards to the quantity of visits on the different pages of the website based on your explicit, prior consent;
- Category 2: to follow up your request based on the performance of a contract and to send direct marketing, newsletters, promotions from Native Nation based on our legitimate interest regarding existing clients;
- **Category 3**: to send direct marketing, newsletters, promotions from Native Nation and provide you with information related to the future offers that might interest you with your explicit, prior consent. You can indicate at any time that you no longer wish to receive our newsletters through the opt-out option or by contacting us directly by mail;
- Category 4: to offer you the possibility to enter into a contest for which you requested and inform you about the results, based on the performance of a contract and send you direct marketing with your explicit, prior consent;
- **Category 5**: communicated by commercial partners of Native Nation and based on the consent for transfer of data;
- **Category 6**: for management purposes within Native Nation based on our legitimate interest for continuing offering our services and maintaining our contacts for Native Nation;
- Category 7: for recruiting purposes of Native Nation based on the performance of a contract.



3.2. Direct marketing

We also use your personal data for direct marketing, newsletters, offers and promotions, on the legal basis of our legitimate interest with regard to existing customers or your explicit, prior consent in all other cases.

You can indicate at any time that you no longer wish to receive our newsletters by clicking on the link in each of our direct mailings or by contacting us directly by mail or telephone.

Article 4. Disclosure of personal data with third parties

- 4.1. In certain circumstances, we may share your personal data with third parties:
 - public authorities, courts and police forces on the basis of a court order or in order to comply with other mandatory laws or regulations,
 - financial institutions,
 - insurance institutions.
 - [If you transfer personal data to other recipients, you should mention this here (such as external consultants, distribution network, partner companies, ...)].
- 4.2. If we ever cease our activities or transfer them to someone else, for example because we go bankrupt or sell our business, your personal data may be transferred to new entities or third parties who will take over all or part of our business. In that case, we will always inform you in advance to the best of our ability, but you acknowledge that this may not be technically or commercially feasible under all circumstances.

Article 5. Storage of the personal data

Your personal data will be stored as long as necessary for the purposes of the processing and as well as your contractual relationship between you and Native Nation. Personal data obtained by entering into a contest or subscribing for a newsletter will be stored for 1 year.

Personal data obtained for management purposes (public relations, suppliers) will be stored for 2 years.

Article 6. Your rights

You have the right to access your personal data and the ways in which we use them at any time, free of charge. You have the right to request us to correct, supplement or remove your personal data. In a number of cases listed in the GDPR, you may also ask us to limit the processing of your personal data. You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data if you have serious and legitimate reasons that exceed our need to process your data. You also have the right to object at any time to the use of personal data for direct



marketing purposes, even without having to give a reason. You have the right to request your personal data in digital and readable form and/or to have them transferred to another service provider of your choice. Insofar as our processing is based on your prior consent, you have the right to revoke that consent at any time.

Native Nation may never be held liable in any way for direct or indirect damage resulting from a wrong or improper use of the personal data by a third party.

Native Nation warns you that the Website can include links, hyperlinks or references to other websites, that are not controlled or managed by Native Nation and to which this Privacy Policy does not apply. Native Nation is not liable for the content of these websites, or for the offers, products and services offered by those. Native Nation advises you to carefully read the Privacy Policy of every website that you visit, given that these rules can differ from the present Privacy Policy.

Article 8. Cookies

Our website uses Cookies and similar technologies to distinguish your preferences from those of the other users of our Website. This allows us to offer you a better experience when you visit our Website and to optimize our Website in the meantime. Without your prior consent, we only place strictly necessary cookies. For all other cookies, we are obligated to ask for your consent in order to use or save cookies and similar technologies on your computer or mobile devices.
